Explain how you see yourself helping others, now or in the future. This could be through your career, volunteering, or just how you live your life.

- Personal statement describing your goals and community involvement (275-300 word count).
- One essay on provided topics or questions (275-300 word count)
- Letter of good standing and support from Coach (Aden Bowman applicant), AP Art or AP Calculus teacher (Evan Hardy applicant), or Pastor (New Life Church Saskatoon applicant).
- Copy of a valid proof of age (Birth Certificate, Passport, Driver's License or Government issued ID).
- Copy of a valid proof of residency (Government issued ID that shows current address).
