Explain how you see yourself helping others, now or in the future. This could be through your career, volunteering, or just how you live your life.

6. Application guidelines

Complete Application Must Include:

- Completed application form
- Official high school transcript
- Personal statement describing your goals and community involvement
- One essay on provided topic or questions, minimum 275-300 word count.
- Letter of good standing and support must be written on official letterhead from Coach (Aden Bowman applicant), AP or AP Calculus Art teacher (Evan Hardy applicant), or Pastor (New Life Saskatoon applicant)
- Copy of a valid Proof of age (Birth Certificate, Passport, Driver's License or Government issued ID)
- Copy of a valid proof of residency (Government issued ID that shows current address)

7. Terms and conditions

- Proof of university registration must be provided prior to the disbursement of funds.
- Applicants must maintain an 80% or overall average (GPA of 3.2) or above each academic year to remain eligible for the next disbursement
